Abstracts shall be written **in one A4 page**. Font Times New Roman, font size 12, margins: top, bottom - 2 cm, side margins - 2.5 cm, line spacing - 1, indentation - 1 cm. Alignment of the text based on the page width.

The file with abstracts should be named "author-t.doc", where the "author" should be replaced with the author, who will be attending the Congress, **written in Latin letters**, for instance, Petrov-t.doc. Abstracts must be saved in Microsoft Word format.

For purposes of clarity and information abstracts may include a table, drawing or a diagram. The diagram should be implemented in ChemDraw programs, ChemWindow or ISIS / Draw, using Arial Cyr font size 10. Use of other graphics and fonts are highly undesirable. Aligning of drawings in the middle of the page shall be without indentation.

It is required to summarize in the abstract the aim of the paper, its basic idea, proposed way of solution, results and a brief discussion. Details of the research/survey should not be described.

References [1] should be made based on the sample as given below.

Abstracts not complying with the requirements would not be published.
